

Washburn Education Department Student Teaching Information
Frequently Asked Questions!!



1. How do I apply to student teach in Spring 2014? *Complete the Student Teacher Application which can be found online at <http://reflective-educator.wikispaces.com/>*
2. Do I need to meet with my advisor? *Yes, plan to go over the Student Teacher Application and Information for Student Teachers (both are in the Reflective Educator Wiki). Your advisor will be notified when you submit the application electronically on or before Monday, April 29, 2013!!*
3. Are there scholarships for which I can apply? *Scholarship Applications are due after the first of the year, 2014. Check for due dates and the Scholarship Application on the Washburn Education Department web site under "Scholarships."*
4. Should I work during Student Teaching? *It is not recommended by the Washburn Education Faculty that you work during the student teaching semester since you will be working fulltime as a Student Teacher. Extra time will be needed after school days end to plan and gather materials for teaching lessons or completing course assignments.*
5. Are there other courses I enroll in during Student Teaching other than the student teaching courses? *Yes, ED 400 (Understanding the Schools) and ED 405 (Classroom Management).*
6. May I enroll in non-education courses during the Student Teaching semester? *No, all other degree requirements must be completed prior to the student teaching semester.*
7. Where can I be placed for the Student Teaching field experience? *Any accredited school district within 1 to 1 1/2 hours of the Washburn campus. If you have any questions about placements contact Dr. Denise Salsbury, Carnegie #205, 670-1473, denise.salsbury@washburn.edu*
8. Do I get to choose the school/s for the Student Teaching field experience? *In the Student Teaching Application provide information about your field experience preferences.*
9. Are there restrictions for the Student Teaching field experience preferences? *You will not be placed in a school that you attended or where your family members or friends attend school. Contact Dr. Salsbury if you have questions about your preferences.*
10. When do we meet next to find out about our Student Teaching field experience placements? *Plan to attend a Fall Follow-up meeting to obtain information about goal setting & course expectations, and then the Student Teacher Meet & Greet on Friday, December 6, 2013 in Morgan #270 at 4:00-6:30pm to meet your University Supervisor, find out about your placement, and learn other information about the Student Teaching semester. **Please check the wiki during the Fall for updates.***
